We are committed to ensuring the operations at the Melbourne Regional Landfill have a minimal impact on the local community. From air quality to the production of renewable energy and water quality, we work hard to ensure there is no unacceptable risk to the health of the local community.

We are always screening the waste that enters the Melbourne Regional Landfill. The first check occurs at the weighbridge and again at the operational face to ensure no hazardous materials form part of the landfill. If we spot something that isn't permitted on site, we remove it and dispose of it correctly. We also try to contact the person bringing these materials onto our site, to ensure they understand what is accepted on site and to prevent a re-occurrence.



Part of what we do includes daily monitoring and visual inspections of the landfill area to remove any litter. We regularly sample and test leachate and groundwater at the site, and monitor gas migration and surface emission.



We regularly monitor and review our site operations to make sure the way waste is collected and transported has minimal interactions with the local community.



We are accountable to the Victorian EPA for the operation of the site and must abide by set conditions around waste discharge and acceptance.
