We're strict on safety at the Melbourne Regional Landfill and this includes all the drivers that enter our site.

We work this way to make sure that vehicles are not queuing on public roads and there is minimal noise disturbances to the local community.

The wheel wash helps to reduce the mud tracked on the trucks' tyres being dropped on local roads.

On average, between 300 and 400 trucks visit the landfill each day. Seasonal factors may vary this from time to time.



The main access to the landfill is along Christies Road, which together with vehicle routes from the Western Freeway, Ballarat Road and Hopkins Road have been designed to minimize impacts on the local community.



We currently work on site from 12am until 5pm, and our permit allows us to manage operations outside of this, if required.
