To protect the local environment we take and test samples of the on site groundwater quarterly.

We do this to make sure our on-site environmental protection controls are working. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) audit these samples and our environmental performance is published annually on the Victorian EPA website www.epa.vic.gov.au.

When organic matter decomposes a liquid called leachate is produced. We collect and treat the leachate on site so that it does not contaminate the local water supply.



All our landfill waste cells are constructed in line with the standards and regulations set out by the EPA.



We actively extract leachate from all our landfill cells and put it into evaporation ponds. This also helps to reduce any odour.



We reduce future impacts on soil, air and water quality in the local community by capping all landfill cells once they have been filled.
